Where do you get your information about caring for babies and young children?

We learn about parenting from our mothers, aunts, clinics, magazines, places of worship, television and radio. Now you can get information about parenting from an app on your phone! The Wordworks App doesn't replace the knowledge you already have; it will give you some new and interesting ideas about how to support babies' and young children's learning and help their brains to grow.


The Wordworks App



Open the Wordworks App. Select your Gmail account to sign up. (If you don't have a Gmail account, you will need to set one up.)


Select the language you prefer. Tap CONTINUE. Add your personal details, including your location and child's details.

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
Choose YES. Wait for the app content to download.
