Ready Steady Read Write Programme – Tutoring Policy

Tutors are the heart of the Ready Steady Read Write Programme and work done by the Coordinators and tutors is deeply valued. Tutors from all backgrounds, with all levels of experience, and of all ages (over 16 years) are welcome.

As a tutor using the Ready Steady Read Write Programme I will need to:

- attend training (two mornings)
- commit to working with children for two hours a week for at least six months
- respect the confidentiality of the children who I work with, and not talk about children's progress outside of the school context

- treat children with kindness, use positive language and praise the effort each child makes
- show respect and consideration towards teachers and other tutors
- arrange my own transport to and from the site
- make every effort to be reliable and punctual and inform the Co-ordinator if I am not able to attend on a particular day
- follow the guidelines in the tutor's manual and implement what has been taught in training
- follow the guidance of the Co-ordinator
- keep my kit organised and tidy and assist with keeping the tutoring room tidy
- return my kit to the Co-ordinator if I leave the programme
- complete registers and assist with record-keeping
- ensure the safety of children at all times and ensure that I understand my responsibilities under the child protection policy of the school/organisation
- check with the Co-ordinator before taking photos of children
- be aware that photographs might be taken of tutors working with children to promote and share the programme. It is my responsibility to make it known if I would prefer not to be included in a photograph
- work on the Ready Steady Read Write Programme entirely at my own risk, and be responsible for any loss or injury that occurs during tutoring
- show respect for children and other tutors by ensuring that cell phones are on silent during lessons.
